

Langhorne Borough Special Council Meeting
December 3, 2024

A Langhorne Borough Special Council Meeting was held at Council Chambers on Tuesday, December 3, 2024. President Culleton called the session to order at 7:01 p.m. and invited those in attendance to pledge allegiance to the Flag.

IN ATTENDANCE: President Nancy Culleton; Vice President Kathy Horwatt; Councilpersons Scott Haldeman, Anthony Marfia, and Adam Zielinski; Mayor Joe Taylor; Solicitor Barbara Kirk; Interim Borough Manager Mary Zimmerman; consultant Paul Leonard

ABSENT: Councilpersons Bob Cumming and Tim Harris

DISCUSSION: President Culleton introduced Mary Zimmerman, who is currently serving as the Borough's Interim Manager, and Paul Leonard, candidate for temporary employment as mentor and consultant. Manager Zimmerman and Mr. Leonard were excused before Council entered into Executive Session.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Council entered into Executive Session at 7:09 p.m. and emerged from Executive Session at 8:35 p.m. Mr. Leonard joined the last portion of the session to answer questions from Council.

MOTION: On motion of Councilperson Zielinski, seconded by Vice President Horwatt, Council voted 5-0 to approve Resolution 2024-XX, to provide a \$500 bonus to Clerk Gabriel Tenaglia in recognition of his work as interim manager from November 14th to November 22nd, 2024.

MOTION: On motion of Councilperson Marfia, seconded by Councilperson Haldeman, Council voted 5-0 to approve Resolution 2024-XX, to employ Paul Leonard as a consultant to the Borough and a mentor to the office staff for sixteen hours per week for five weeks of work between December 4th, 2024 and January 15th, 2025, at a salary of \$1,840 per week.

MOTION: On motion of Councilperson Zielinski, seconded by Councilperson Haldeman, Council voted 5-0 to approve Resolution 2024-XX, to employ Mary Zimmerman as Interim Borough Manager for a period from November 22nd, 2024, until no later than June 30th, 2025, for a weekly salary calculated on the basis of a salary of \$76,000 per year.

ADJOURNMENT: On motion of Councilperson Haldeman, seconded by Councilperson Marfia, Council voted 5-0 to adjourn at 8:45 p.m.
