

**Langhorne Borough Work Session**  
**December 19, 2024**

A Langhorne Borough Work Session was held at Council Chambers on Wednesday, December 19, 2024. President Culleton called the session to order at 7:03 p.m. and invited those in attendance to pledge allegiance to the Flag.

**IN ATTENDANCE:** President Culleton; Councilpersons Scott Haldeman, Anthony Marfia, Tim Harris, Bob Cumming, and Adam Zielinski; Solicitor Barbara Kirk; Interim Manager Mary Zimmerman

**ABSENT:** Vice President Kathleen Horwatt; Clerk Gabe Tenaglia

**MOTION:** On motion of Councilperson Cumming, seconded by Councilperson Zielinski, Council voted 6-0 to approve payment of the bills.

**2025 POLICE WAGE RESOLUTION:** Chief John Godzieba had proposed rounding up the 3% wage increase to the nearest dollar, but Treasurer Ellyn Schoen put in an exact 3% increase. After some discussion, Council elected to approve the wage increase at exactly 3%.

**MOTION:** On motion of Councilperson Cumming, seconded by Councilperson Marfia, Council voted 6-0 to approve Resolution 2024-41: A RESOLUTION OF LANGHORNE BOROUGH, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING FORTH THE SALARY SCALE AND STANDARDS FOR THE LANGHORNE BOROUGH POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE 2025 FISCAL YEAR with a flat 3% wage increase.

**MOTION:** On motion of Councilperson Cumming, seconded by Councilperson Zielinski, Council voted 6-0 to approve Resolution 2024-40: A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF LANGHORNE, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING AND RETAINING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 IN THE AMOUNT OF 14.0 MILLS FOR GENERAL BOROUGH PURPOSES, 2.45 MILLS FOR STREET LIGHTING PURPOSES, 1.65 MILLS FOR FIRE TAX PURPOSES, 0.06875 MILLS FOR RESCUE SQUAD TAX PURPOSES, AND 0.0275 MILLS FOR SHADE TREE TAX PURPOSES, WITHOUT ANY INCREASE IN SAID RATES, AS PROVIDED UNDER THE PENNSYLVANIA BOROUGH CODE.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** Council entered into Executive Session at 7:12 p.m. to discuss legal and real estate matters and emerged from Executive session at 8:12 p.m.

**ADJOURNMENT:** On motion of Councilperson Harris, seconded by Councilperson Marfia, Council voted 6-0 to adjourn at 8:12 p.m.
