1. The applicant must have a valid Driver's License or ID Card to be copied.
2. Applicants seeking to register for the purpose of soliciting funds shall verify by oath or affirmation, properly notarized their full name, address, criminal history, and punishment.
3. Payment of the \$100.00 fee shall be made payable to LANGHORNE BOROUGH.
4. The permit is valid for thirty (30) days from date of issue.
5. The applicant shall provide an identification card showing their name, address, photograph, name of organization or business and telephone number. (section 5)
6. No signs are permitted unless a sign permit has been issued and all conditions and regulations of the zoning ordinance have been complied with. (section 9)
7. Permit may be revoked should it develop that the applicant lied, or if applicant is convicted of disorderly conduct within the Borough of Langhorne or convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude. (section 6)
8. The applicant must display the identification card and permit at all times. (section 6)
9. Charitable organizations may request that the fee be waived. The request must be submitted in writing sufficiently in advance of the application so that Borough Council will have an opportunity to act thereon. The waiving of the fee does not exempt the applicant from completing the application. (section 11)
